Renee was always proud of her Cleveland Jewish heritage and all of her life would tell people that her grandfather Simon Talisman was the rabbi who opened the Cleveland Jewish Center on Kinsman. That Center was an important part of the Jewish community for many years – especially "the Schvitz". Renee returned to Cleveland in October of 2016, moving into Montefiore...When she did, her health perked up immediately. She started to attend Torah classes, go to services and parties and even volunteered with some paperwork as well as greeting new patients who arrived. She even learned she loved bingo!! She made her mark at Montefiore and her death, even though her health was failing, was an unexpected loss to many who had gotten to know her there, and see her on her walker moving all over the building socializing . She even named the internal patient newsletter "the Schmooze News" - she was so proud her idea was chosen!! Up until the end, you could see her downstairs all dressed up, jewelry and all, greeting everybody and kibbitzing.
