Howard Grossman peacefully passed away at age 58. Here is a posthumous message from him and deets about the upcoming fiesta to celebrate his life: “Hey guys, it’s me, Howard. Don’t worry, I took care of everything before Grim came and got me. On Friday, I had a stroke and was taken immediately to the operating room to bust a clot (not a move, that would have been more fun). 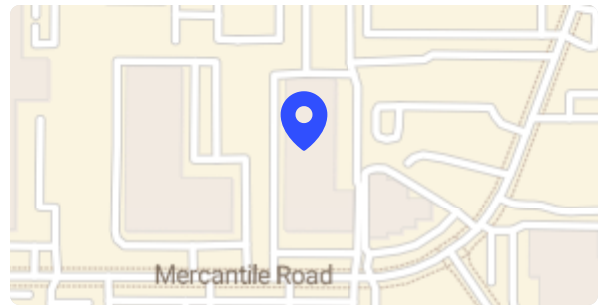
